3 FLS box using Bowel Anastomosis Training Simulator

#### **Procedures Lap**:

Lap chole Sleeve

Anastomosis options:

- -Sleeve to bypass or OAGB
- -Duodenal switch
- -Hiatal dissection (preceded by BL chest tube)
- -Laparoscopic SBR/anastomosis
